

Prospects for New Board Member

*In 1984 the Huntsville Pilgrimage Association was formed as a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization. It is controlled and operated by an all volunteer “working” membership board.

*The purpose of the HPA is to advance the education, appreciation, and preservation of the historic heritage of Huntsville and Madison County, by means of annual and special events, including strolls, tours, and the membership of the Angels of Maple Hill Cemetery, as well as other development tools such as dues, donations, grants, and capital campaigns.

*Proceeds from events and development activity will be used to fund the preservation, repair and maintenance of historic sections of Maple Hill Cemetery, including but not limited to monuments, mausoleums, and fencing, as well as other historic restoration as approved by the board.

Board membership is composed of active, charter/lifetime, and advisory directors, with the annual membership starting on January 1 and ending December 31*.

*Active members will control the affairs, funds, and property of the Association.

*Active members must reside in Madison County.

*Active members serve a term of 4 years and may serve 2 consecutive terms for a total of 8 years.

*Active members will participate in each event sponsored by the Association, with events currently scheduled for a tour in the Spring, and a cemetery tour in the Fall.

*Active members are encouraged to join or be assigned to several committees within the Association.

*Active members must attend seven of the nine regular monthly meeting during the year. Monthly meetings are not held in June, July and December. Monthly meetings are scheduled for the first Monday of the month, except in September for the second Monday.

*All active members will submit a minimum annual contribution of \$85. This includes board dues of \$50 and a membership in the Angels of Maple Hill Cemetery of \$35.
